

Alcohol Waiver and Acceptance of Responsibility - International

- The minimum drinking age for all alcoholic beverages on all Royal Caribbean International ships is 21 years of age.
 - However, on ships in Europe and South America, where the legal drinking age is lower than 21, a parent who is <u>sailing with</u> his or her son(s) and/or daughter(s) who is between the ages of 18 to 20, may sign a waiver allowing the 18 to 20 year old to consume alcoholic beverages.
 - The 18- to 20 year old must agree to comply with Royal Caribbean International's policies, including among other things, agreeing to not provide alcoholic beverages to any other person, regardless of age. Restrictions apply, and this policy is subject to change without notice.
- An individual's age on the date of sailing determines his or her status for the entire cruise vacation.
- Guests are not allowed to bring alcoholic beverages onboard for consumption or any other use. Alcoholic beverages that are purchased in ports-of-call or from the Shops On Board will be stored by the ship and delivered to guest staterooms on the last day of the sailing. For back-to-back guests, liquor purchases during the guest's first or second cruise vacation will be delivered to the guest's stateroom within 24 hours prior of final departure from the ship.
- Security may inspect containers (water bottles, soda bottles, mouthwash, luggage etc.) and will dispose of containers holding alcohol. Royal Caribbean International's Guest Vacation Policy may be enforced, up to and including departure from the ship, if a guest violates any alcohol policy. Guests under the age of 21 will not have alcohol returned to them.
- Guests who violate any alcohol policies, (over consume, provide alcohol to people under age 21, demonstrate irresponsible behavior, or attempt to conceal alcoholic items at security and or luggage check points or any other time), may be requested to leave the ship or not allowed to board, at their own expense, in accordance with our Guest Vacation Policies.
- Royal Caribbean International reserves the right to revoke or otherwise restrict drinking privileges of any guest, regardless of age. Even if all criteria are met, shipboard personnel may elect, and have the option to, not grant the waiver or any such drinking privileges. The waiver may not apply when the vessel is in certain territorial waters.
